Radio Frequency Identification (RFID):
Every TamaWrap® includes 4 RFID tags

Tama Cut Indicator™:
Helps in locating the recommended cutting zone in order to minimize the risk of cotton contamination.



The TamaWrap® Z-LOCK® wrap portion concept:
TamaWrap® is made of pre-cut wrap portions in order to eliminate the potential of plastic fragments.
The Z-lock® system connects and separates each individual portion on a roll, so the roll is made from 24 “ready to use” portions.
The Z-lock® system assures the next portion is ready to feed correctly.

Every core is marked on its left hand side, to assist correct installation:

- Black dots or blue stripe on the core.
- A label inside the core.

- Integrated with John Deere Harvest ID, Cotton Pro and the John Deere Operations Center.

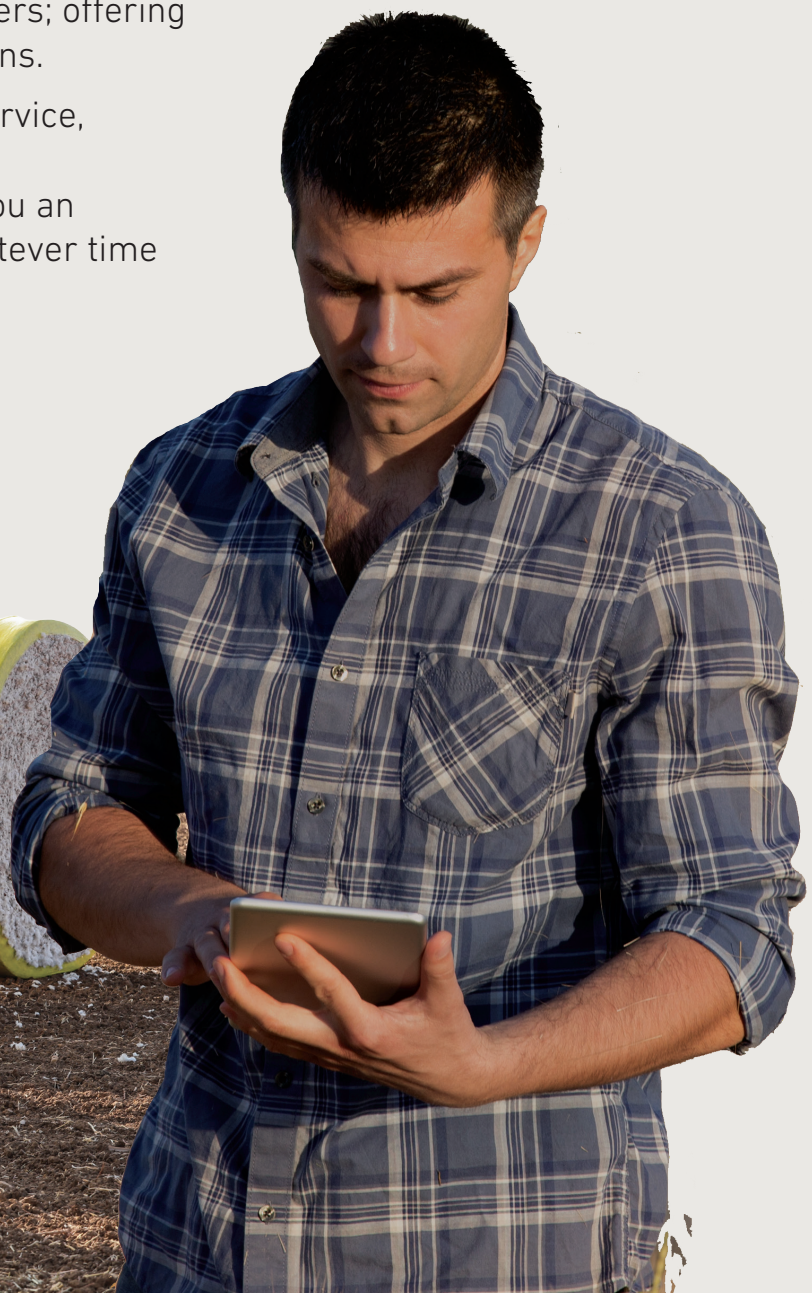

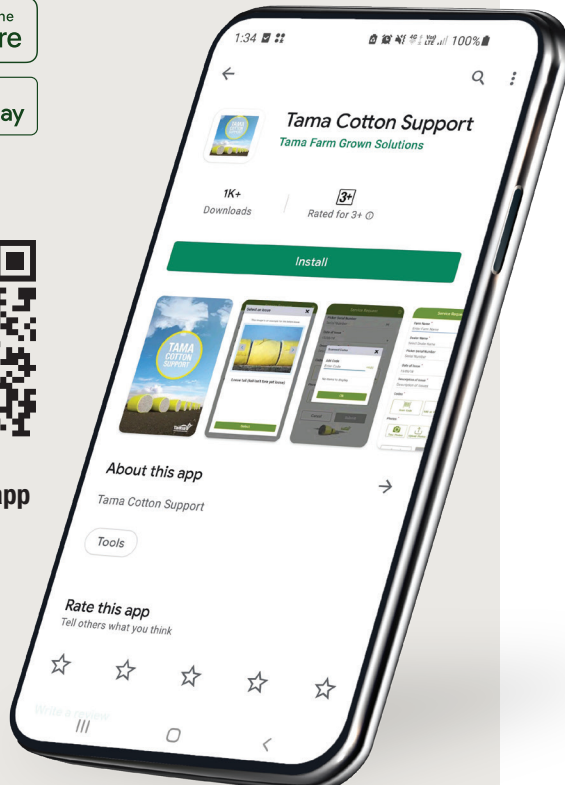

Core Labels & Maintenance for TamaWrap® Products

Model Year, Handling and Storage Instructions

As we begin production on the 2025 Model Year product we will change the color coding on the pallet label and on the roll labels:

Labels color	Orange	Dark Pink	Yellow

We highly recommend that you and your customers exhaust your supply of 2024 product early in the use season of 2025.

Handling Recommendations*

- Handle one pallet at a time
- Use forklift with lift capacity of at least 4,400 lbs (2 tons)
- Use long forks When handling pallets from the narrow end, to minimize damage
- Use pallet puller when unloading pallets from a truck

Storage Requirements

- Store TamaWrap® under roof in an enclosed structure and avoid extended exposure to sunlight and moisture
- Double stacking of pallets is permissible with proper handling equipment
- To be used within two seasons

Recommendations

- Please ensure the previous seasons product is used first. Rotate stock accordingly

Tama warrants and agrees that the individual wrap portion by individual serial number used in John Deere Round Module Cotton Harvesters sold hereunder shall be free of defect, in workmanship and/or materials, for a period of 24 months following the first delivery of TamaWrap® to the buyer and for 6 months after the module was made, provided that:

- The TamaWrap® is kept in their original packaging.
- The TamaWrap® is stored under cover and are not exposed to extreme heat, direct sunlight, or moisture during storage. Double stacking of pallets is permissible with proper handling equipment.
- TamaWrap® products are designed to be staged outside for a maximum of 6 months. Make sure modules are not left exposed to the sun for a longer period of time.

GENERAL NOTE

- Pink TamaWrap® is available across all options while stocks last. To be sold on a first in basis.
- Blue TamaWrap® is available across all options while stocks last. To be sold on a first in basis.
- Stock left over from 2023/2024 Season will be dispatched first.

ITEM 1 PRICING

- Minimum one pallet per order (NO SPLIT PALLETS).
- All pricing is listed Excluding GST.
- Freight paid to dealership branches for one pallet plus per delivery.
- Freight paid on farm for 6 pallets plus per delivery (Conditions apply, refer to Item 2).
- Tama Australia Terms and Conditions of sale.

ITEM 2 RAMP DOWN

- Cancellation / reduction to order quantities can be made up to, but no shorter than, two weeks prior to requested delivery period.
- For on-farm deliveries, if the change made to the order results in less than 6 pallets minimum, then the order defaults to a Dealership Branch delivery.
- Ramp Down Option is not applicable for Option Four.

ITEM 3 RAMP UP - BACK AGAIN FOR 2025

- Ramp up option allows customers to order 15% of their Option1/Option2 and Option 3* order at the original invoiced price.
 - In order to qualify for the volume discount, dealers must include customer contact details on all initial orders.
 - For in season orders to be added to a customer total, dealers must include original customer details and reference any previous order number's.
- * Special conditions apply

ITEM 4 ORDER PROCESS

- Refer to dealership order process for orders terms and conditions.
- For on-farm deliveries, order must clearly show two GPS Google Map references for the delivery address.

ITEM 5 ON FARM 6 PALLET MINIMUM PER DELIVERY

- Simon National Carriers only.
- Property must be accessible by Tama nominated B Double transport.
- Property must have adequate mechanical lifting devices to unload pallets from the truck.
- Customers or their appointed representatives must unload the truck and sign Proof of Delivery Docket.
- Any damages or defects relating to freight must be recorded at this time and reported to Tama Australia within three working days.
- Additional Freight charges will be applied if freighter is unable to unload due to customer actions.
- Required information is minimum two GPS locations from Google Maps of the delivery address. UHF/CB radio channels are also advisable. The more information the better.

ITEM 6 FREIGHT & STORAGE

- All TamaWrap® logistics and freight will be handled by Simon National Carriers
- TamaWrap® storage is in Brisbane, Sydney, Townsville and Darwin.
- All freight paid for by Tama Australia in accordance with the 2024/25 Program, must be organised and approved by Tama Australia.
